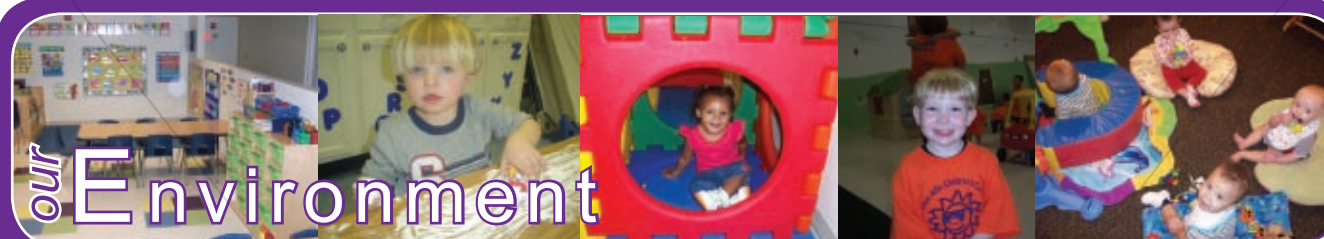
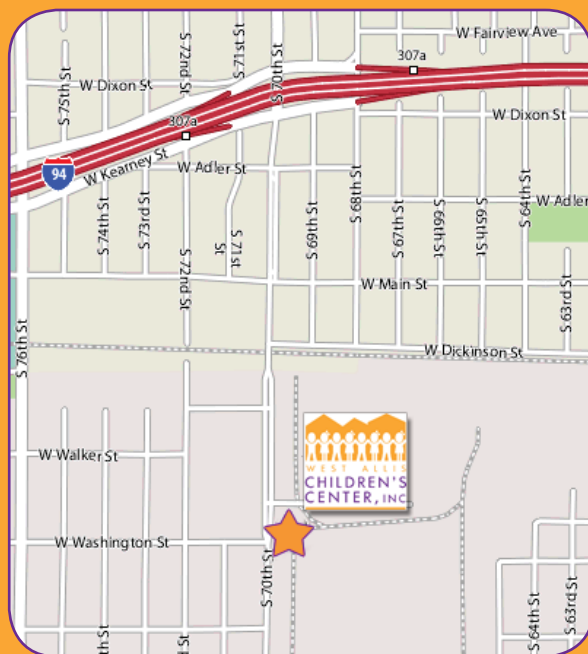

» **The Infant and Toddler Wing**

## our Programs

### • Infant Program

- » Bright Baby Curriculum allows babies to experience the excitement and joy of their 1st year
- » Age-appropriate, multi-sensory activities invite them to talk, play, move, sign, and read
- » Plenty of developmentally appropriate toys that are rotated often for cleanliness and enrichment
- » Partners in care - teachers follow parent's care plan to allow consistency between home and center
- » Formula, cereal, and baby food provided
- » Teachers are specifically trained in infant care as well as SIDS and Shaken Baby Syndrome reduction
- » Each infant child is assigned their own crib
- » Bibs and linens are provided
- » Mother's lounge – allows a peaceful respite for breast-feeding
- » Child's milestones are recorded to track their growth and development

### • Toddler Program

- » High Reach Curriculum for Toddlers allows them to explore with their boundless energy in a rich learning environment.

### • Preschool Program

### • School-Age Program

- » Off-school days & summertime children will participate in "Adventure Camp"
  - Children who are currently enrolled are guaranteed enrollment.
  - Children will visit McKinley Park located directly across the street inviting them to enjoy 2 baseball diamonds, a basketball court, climbing equipment, tetherball, and lots of room to run.
  - Attend weekly field trips to local recreational and cultural attractions.
  - Children in 1st grade and up may participate in overnight camp at Spencer Lake kids' camp where they can fish, swim, roast marshmallows, and sleep in real log cabins.
